Basic Principles to Apply in Order to Understand the Bible

- Look for key words and clauses
 - o Purpose (Aim)
 - Result (Consequences)
 - o Causal (Reason)
 - o Conditional (If...then)
 - o Comparative (Comparison)
 - Explanatory

- Determine the Tense of the verbs
 - o Past, Present, Future
- Understand every word in its context
 - o Consider the Immediate context:
 - Verse, Paragraph, Chapter
 - o Consider Remote context
 - Chapter, Book, Books

Important! Always compare Scripture with Scripture in order to allow the Scriptures to interpret themselves.

- When reading the Bible be sure to note the "Type" or "Form" of revelation God is using to communicate His truth.
 - Narrative
 - Gospels/Life of Christ
 - Doctrine
 - Parables
 - Poetry
 - Prophesy
 - o Then interpret each "Type" according to the Biblical pattern of interpretation
- Apply the Biblical truth (command or principle) from the Biblical situation to your own life.
